Complaints to the BBC: April 2016

The BBC answered over **16,000** complaints from the audience during April 2016. These ranged from a small number of complaints about alleged breaches of editorial guidelines through to a much larger collection of views about programme content and services.

Topics raised this month included complaints about Radio 4's D on't Make Me Laugh on A pril 21 from listeners who felt jokes relating to the Royal Family and The Queen were inappropriate.

There were also complaints from viewers who were disappointed that Gardeners' W orld wasn't broadcast on A pril 8 due to coverage of the England v Belgium W omen's Euro 2017 football qualifier.
