

Complaints to the BBC: June 2015

The BBC answered just over **14,300** complaints from the audience during June 2015. These ranged from a small number of complaints about alleged breaches of editorial guidelines through to a much larger collection of views about programme content and services.

Topics raised this month included the new format of the Wimbledon highlights show, Wimbledon 2Day, which some viewers were disappointed by.

We also received complaints from viewers who were unhappy with the language used by Kanye West during his headline set at the Glastonbury Festival.
