Complaints to the BBC: September 2017

The BBC answered just over **13,000** complaints from the audience during September 2017. These ranged from a small number of complaints about alleged breaches of editorial guidelines through to a much larger collection of views about programme content and services.

This month, some people felt there was insufficient coverage of the floods and casualties in South East Asia compared with the coverage given to the storms and flooding also experienced in the United States.
